

There are several important items to be circulated and requiring your participation at the Center.

1. Women's Temporary Housing Switchboard is now in service and works thus:
  - a. There are three notebooks Looking for a Place, Looking for Roommates, and Temporary Housing Notebook. The first two are for permanent arrangements and the notebooks (red and blue) are in the notebooks case in the Sitting Room. The Temporary Housing (yellow) notebook is in the Women's Housing Switchboard mailbox in the Staffing Room and should be returned there when finished using. The policy on these notebooks are as follows:
  - b. No information is to be given out over the phone. We made a promise that the info contain therein is confidential and I'm sure you wouldn't want your number given out to every stranger. Women have to come to the Center to use the notebooks, even the Temporary notebook.
  - c. Please write questions and messages on paper and put into the Twmporary Women's Housing mailbox (upper righthand corner). Also, please do not give out Lottie's or Kathleen's phone numbers --- leave messages. Also, we could use more volunteers to help out!
2. Room Sign Up Book . The Center is being care for by a number of diligent people and if no one is signed up to use a room in the Room Reservational Notebook, then the Center either will not be opened or else closed before you get there. Therefore, you Must sign up ahead of time (at least a couple of days) so no one will take your place or shut you out. New groups want to use the Center and Core and Projects needs to see how much it is being occupied. If you have standing meetings every week, just sign up for months ahead.
3. NEW ENGLAND CONSUMER SAVINGS SHOW September 19-21. This weekend show will display all kinds of economic ideas, and we think that it would be a fine idea to participate with a booth and talk about alternative Women's Issues. Over 100,000 people will go and the Women's Center and Women's Movement needs the exposure and outreach to all those suburban and urban women! We have got a double booth for the price of one called the Hospitality Booth which is 10' x 20' long with back and side walls. We are asking the projects, staffers and anyone you may know who has feminist issues to participate in the planning and show. We can sell publications to make money and collect people's names for outreach and possible fundraising efforts in the future.

We need specific topics such as Therapy, Elizabeth Stone, Houseworkers, Nutrition, School, Alternatives of all sorts, and also women to generally be present to represent the Women's Center. We are requesting that All The Projects Get Involved and we can make this a Center Effort. We can make displays, and take sections of time to woman the booth.
